## COURSE PROGRAMME AND CONTENT 2021

The **European Training Consortium Public Health and Health promotion (ETC-PHHP)** is a European and International learning network founded in 1991 and involves 12 Higher Education partners from across Europe.

For almost 30 years ETC-PHHP has been host to an annual summer school, providing opportunities for participants from different social, cultural and political contexts and an interest or role in health promotion, to come together. A primary goal is to expand participants perspectives and horizons of health promotion whilst challenging frontiers in health promotion policy and practice. Interactive adult learning approaches enable participants to share and co-create new insights and explore possible solutions to complex challenges in health promotion. Whereby the overall experience is greater than the sum of the parts.

This year's course will be delivered in an **online space where** participants and tutors will explore:

- Salutogenesis as a framework for understanding how to enhance Quality of Life for Community Health and Wellbeing;
- Meaningful resources in and by communities;
- Participatory approaches for strengthening community's health and wellbeing.

The **methods** used to achieve these goals are:

- Videos with content about Salutogenesis for Community Health and Wellbeing
- Interactive sessions
- Examples of community associations from different countries
- Workshops
- Group work facilitated by 2 international tutors
- Participatory coffee breaks: exercise, music, dance, open space
- Social activities: drinks in the wonderbar, virtual visit to a museum

Basic **requirements** to access the course include a good internet connection and motivation to learn and share experiences with other participants from many different contexts.

This course carries CPD certification worth **5 ECTS** (The European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System)

## COURSE PARTICIPANTS

We welcome people from different fields of health promotion, public health, local government, NGO and health care backgrounds, including people from sectors such as urban planning, academia, social work, research, management, practice and policy.

The course working language is English. The number of participants is **limited to 35**.
