The doctoral student is obliged to prepare, by April 30 (of a given year) a report on the implementation of scientific research, taking into account scientific achievements, on a template prepared by the Head of the Doctoral School for the period covering a given academic year and, depending on the chosen form: a poster or a multimedia presentation. The assessment of the doctoral student's performance during the Public Review Session is made by a committee appointed by the Head of the Doctoral School. The result of the assessment is entered into the doctoral student's electronic index by the Head of the Doctoral School.
